On Win32:

tiffcp copies the DotRange tag (version 3.8.0 used to crash, see [bug #1029](#)), but 0 255 becomes 200 0 in the destination file in my case.  
tiffinfo crashes on this DotRange file.

Linux (built on Suse10.0):

tiffinfo and tiffcp both cause a Segmentation fault when used on this file.

Commands used:

```
tiffinfo DotRange.tif  
tiffcp DotRange.tif somename
```

You can hex edit the DotRange tag (0x0150) in DotRange.tif to 0x8150. Now tiffinfo and tiffcp no longer crash on the file.
